3. Enrollment is counted at Fall Census. Degrees and certificates awarded is counted by Fiscal Year. The goal for the gap is to move to be zero or greater than zero.

5. Refers to classified, bachelor's degree-seeking undergraduates only, not including students seeking a second bachelor's degree. Also excludes students who are deceased.
6. Classified, bachelor's degree-seeking undergraduates only, not including students seeking a second bachelor's degree. Also excludes students who are deceased. Full-time status based on home campus credits attempted in entry term; bachelor earned at entry UH campus.
7. Pell grant received in entry term.
8. Transfer students are students who transfer external or internal UH credits. Transfers status based on home campus credits attempted in entry term; bachelor earned at entry UH campus.
9. Based on students who received a bachelor's degree. Excludes students seeking a second bachelor's degree. Native Students are students who do not have any transfer credits except for exam-based credits. Includes credits earned at the awarding campus only. Native Hawaiian based on ethnicity code = 'HW'.
10. Refers to early college credit opportunities offered through Advanced Placement, dual enrollment programs (Running Start, Jump Start), summer school, etc.
11. Completion refers to credits earned at the campus or accepted as UH internal transfer credits. Includes previous summer credits. Transfer credits do not include Advanced Placement, Running Start, or Jump Start credits.
12. UH Mānoa only: Prior to Fall 2015, student has a major not equal to GEN (General-Undeclared) or GEAS (General Arts and Sciences) by the start of their second year. Starting Fall 2015, student has a major not equal to EX, EXAH, EXB, EXED, EXHS, EXSS, and EXST (Metamajors) by the start of their second year. Metamajor codes became effective in Spring 2016. UH Hilo and West O'ahu: Student has a major not equal to GEN (General-Undeclared) or GEAS (General Arts and Sciences) by the start of their second year.
13. First-time freshmen enrolled in the fall of the following year. Based on home campus credits attempted in entry term; bachelor earned at entry UH campus.
14. A total of 120 credits are required for graduation in most bachelor's degree programs.

16. Distance learning refers to instruction delivered synchronously or asynchronously where students are separated from the instructor, or offsite instruction.
