**1P1**

**Numerator:** Concentrators who have a cumulative GPA > or = 2.0 in CTE courses and who have stopped program participation in the year reported.

**Denominator:** Concentrators who have stopped program participation in the year reported.

**4P1**

**Numerator:** Concentrators in the year reported (Prior Perkins year) who have stopped program participation and who are placed or retained in employment, military service, or an apprenticeship program within UI quarter following program completion.

**Denominator:** Concentrators in the year reported (Previous Perkins year) who have stopped program participation
