1. Accreditation
 - A campus-wide email was recently sent out by the Chancellor to "kick off" the self-evaluation process.
 - Teams are now working on standards and are in the process of gathering information.

2. CERC
 - Last year's group is still reviewing Program/Unit Reviews and writing Response Memos.
 - To follow will be Recommendation Memo to Chancellor.
 - Revising templates to make information requested more meaningful.

3. COMPASS - Acuplacer
 - The last day for COMPASS testing is November 15th.
 - COMPASS to Acuplacer conversion is effective December 1st.
 - Cost of Accuplacer is \$1.95 per test per student.
 - Institution administrator is Kaleo Pilago.
 - Testing can be done online at high schools.
 - English and Math have determined Cut Scores.

4. STAR GPS Registration
 - Students will be registering for spring 2017 through STAR, beginning November 7th.
 - MyUH registration feature will be turned off.
 - Counselors are testing now.
 - Grace will be doing STAR Training.
 - There was a "bug" with Auto Dev Ed but has since been resolved.
