



Lorenz Maggaard has been a member of PACON since 1991 and is currently the Past-President. He served as Chair of the PACON Hawaii Chapter for many years, and as the general chair for the PACON 2007 and PACON 2008 conferences. He was awarded the PACON Service Award in 1998, the PACON International Award in 2000, and the PACON Fellow Award in 2007. Dr. Maggaard is currently a Professor Emeritus in the Department of Oceanography at the University of Hawaii at Manoa and the Founding Director of the International Center for Climate and Society (ICCS) whose mission is “to develop improved methods of utilizing socio-economic innovation to mitigate and adapt to climate fluctuations and change”. Dr. Maggaard earned his B.S., M.S. and PhD degrees from the University of Kiel, Germany (major: mathematics; minors: physics and oceanography). He came to Hawaii in 1974 and became Professor in the Department of Oceanography in 1975. He served as chairperson of that department from 1984 to 1990 and again from 2005 to 2006. He was also the Associate Dean of the School of Ocean and Earth Science and Technology (SOEST) from 1992 until 2000. While he has worked on problems in physical oceanography for more than 40 years, he is now fully concentrating on research and education in the area of climate and society and is developing a unique cross-disciplinary doctoral program: Environmental Finance.
